- 1. Prosecco Spumante Millesimato, Biscardo Veneto – Italy** **28.95**
A delightfully frothy sparkler with aromatic apple and pear and a crisp palate of succulent fruits.
- 2. Cava Brut Reserva, Sumarroca 2016 Penedes - Spain** **36.00**
Top notch Reserva Cava from an extremely well regarded producer
- 3. Taittinger Brut Reserve Champagne – France** **72.00**
The brilliant body is golden yellow in colour. The bubbles are fine, while the foam is discreet yet lingering. Great quality from a renowned house
- 4. Bollinger Brut Special Cuvee Champagne – France** **75.00**
Delicate blend of the Bollinger Family's finest grapes
- 5. Domaine Des Baumard, Cremant De Loire Blanc Carte Turquoise** **45.00**
This wine captures all the aroma of apple & cherry blossoms

Rounded Soft & Full Whites

- 6. Airen/Sauvignon Blanc La Mancha - Spain** **19.95**
Ripe, rounded and delicious. A zesty, soft white that is ideal as an aperitif or with salads, grilled white meats and fish.
- 7. Viognier, Mont Rocher Pays d'Oc - France** **24.95**
This one is a massive hit, well balanced with crisp acidity, apricot fruit dominating, and just a touch of spice.
- 8. Soave DOC, Campo le Calle, Latium Morini Veneto – Italy** **32.00**
Harvested late, this is more weighty, complex and structured than the regular Soave. Intense and full it has aromas and flavours of stone fruit and a long, mineral finish.
- 9. Chardonnay, The Great Escape, Thistledown Eden Valley – Australia** **32.95**
Citrusy, subtle oak influence and a bright yet creamy palate.
- 10. Macon Villages, 2020 Domaine Fichet Burgundy – France** **34.00**
A rich, generous wine with ripe citrus fruits and hints of the Tropical. Crisp acidity balances and buttery, toasty oak completes the picture.
- 11. Chablis, 2019 Domaine Defaix Burgundy – France** **39.00**
Minerally, flinty notes on the nose with touches of green apple. Elegant, dry and characterised by crisp, citrus flavours overlaid with smoky notes. Long finish.

Rounded Soft & Full Whites

- 12. Blanco, 2019 Fermentado Barrica, Bodegas Luis Cañas** **29.95**
Rioja – Spain
Fermented in French oak barrels, this has an intense and aromatic nose with a rounded and soft palate full of citrus fruit.
- 13. Viognier, 2019 Nettie - California** **31.00**
Aromas of peach and grapefruit combine with subtle floral notes resulting in a delicious refreshing wine
- 14. Chardonnay, 2018/19 Crossbarn Paul Hobbs** **45.00**
Sonoma Coast, California
On the nose a mixture of stone fruit with hints of lemon zest. The juicy palate is filled with slowly unfolding layers of gala apple, nectarine, and apricot with subtle notes of brioche & lees. The round texture is accentuated by vibrant acidity and a pronounced, mineral-driven finish.
- 15. Saint – Aubin 1^{er} Cru – Villes Vignes Chardonnay 2018 - France** **75.00**
Limpid and brilliant, toasted almonds and hazelnuts in a floral and mineral setting with butter honey and citrus fruit.
- 16. Nostros Grand Reserva – Chardonnay Casablanca – Chile** **29.95**
Creamy, Toasty aromas with rich tropical fruit

Crisp, Fresh & Dry Whites

- 20. Catarratto, Palazzo del Mare** **22.95**
Sicily - Italy
Crisp & citrusy with some tropical nuances on the finish. Great with seafood!
- 21. Sauvignon Blanc, Largesse** **23.95**
Cotes de Gascogne - France
An elegant crisp white with vibrant grassy character and hints of tropical fruit. Pairs well with fish and white meat dishes.
- 22. Pinot Grigio, Bella Modella** **22.95**
Veneto – Italy
A beautifully, light, vibrant white to be appreciated for its zesty, citrus character and refreshing quality.
- 23. Chenin Blanc, Raats Original, Stellenbosch – South Africa** **29.95**
Packed with succulent flavours of apple, pineapple and citrus with hints of ginger, honeysuckle and orange blossom and a lovely minerality. Bright and tasty it is made without any oak to preserve the grape's "original" vibrant fresh fruit character.
- 25. Sauvignon Blanc, Oyster Bay, Malborough - New Zealand** **32.00**
Stunningly aromatic tropical fruits and bright citrus notes, with a refreshingly zesty finish.

- 26. Albarino, 2019 Pazo de Senorans**
Galicia – Spain **39.00**
Peach & citrus flavours. Sensational with seafood or White fish.
- 27. Semillon Sauvignon, 2020 Stella Bella**
Margaret River – Australia **34.95**
A classic Margaret River blend of crisp, grassy Sauvignon and tangy, citrusy Semillon. Vibrant and massively refreshing.

- 30. Pinot Grigio Rosé, IGT Bella Modella**
Veneto – Italy **23.95**
A pale salmon pink colour with a delicate yet lively nose of fresh raspberries and wild strawberries. Crisp, light and fragrant on the palate with succulent finish.
- Light, Fragrant Reds
- 40. Tempranillo/Syrah, Castillo del Moro**
La Mancha – Spain **19.95**
Full of juicy bramble and cherry fruit with hints of spice. Deliciously supple and succulent.
- 41. Merlot, Largesse**
Pays d’Oc - France **23.95**
A soft generous style with lusciously textured fruit. Supple, fleshy and well rounded on the palate with a smooth, long finish.
- 42. Montepulciano D’Abruzzo, Altopiano**
Abruzzo, Italy **27.95**
Ruby red colour. A strong fruity scent, containing hints of spices, cherry plum and jam. Well balanced and lasting taste..
- 43. Pinot Noir, Devil’s Creek, Central Otago, New Zealand** **33.00**
Bright, crunchy red fruits, with lashings of red cherries and more than a hint of smoky spice.

Big, Bold & Burly Reds

- 46. Old Vine Garnacha, La Multa, El Escoces Volante**
Calatayud – Spain **24.95**
There aren't many Scotsmen making wine in Calatayud but Norrel Robertson MW is a bit of a maverick! Punching well above its weight, Norrel's Garnacha made from gnarly old vines is rich, concentrated but well balanced with huge, ripe berry fruit, lots of spice and sweet oak.
- 47. Shiraz, "The Opportunist", One Chain Vineyards**
McLaren Vale – Australia **26.95**
A deep, inviting crimson with an intense cassis, plum and bramble nose. Rich, voluptuous and silky on the palate with creamy black fruits and a little savoury smokiness from oak.
- 48. Malbec, 2019 Manos Negras**
Mendoza – Argentina **35.00**
The variety that Argentina has almost claimed as its own. Dark, rich and intense with deep leathery fruit cake like fruit, balanced oak and great length.
- 49. Chateauneuf Du Pape, 2017 Bel Ami, Guillaume Gonnet**
Rhone – France **53.00**
Full bodied and concentrated yet holding on nicely to its elegance. Long & round with a generous finish.
- 50. Shiraz, 2013 Majella**
Connawara – Australia **49.00**
Cherry and coffee aromas with soft tannins and touches of sweet fruit and leather.
- 51. Malbec, Bramare, 2015/16 Lujan de Cuyo**
Mendoza – Argentina **55.00**
Inky, dense violet in colour, this Malbec offers a fine balance of poise and power. The nose brims with raspberries, anise, cherries and black pepper, while on the palate, the full-bodied impression carries flavours of red liquorice, figs and hints of smoke.
- 52. Amarone della Valpolicella DOC 'Campo Leon', 2015 Latium Morini**
Veneto – Italy **69.00**
Healthy fruit at peak ripeness is hand harvested and air dried for 100 to 120 days in small baskets. This wine has fantastic ripe, healthy fruit aromas, a rich and profound palate and superb, fleshy tannin and length. Balancing minerality makes this superbly drinkable.

Classic & Elegant Reds

- 60. Pinot Noir, Nostros**
Casablanca – Chile **24.95**
Bright, wild strawberry and raspberry fruits dominate a soft, supple palate which leads through to a gentle, warming finish.
- 61. Valpolicella DOC, 2018 Latium Morini**
Veneto – Italy **29.95**
Fantastic varietal aromas on the nose of ripe fruit, cherries and a touch of spice. Lifted and fresh. A great wine to accompany a wide variety of dishes.
- 62. Rioja Crianza, 2017 Finca Manzanos**
Rioja – Spain **29.95**
Twelve months oak ageing give a little complexity and softens the wine yielding a well balanced ripe fruited wine with a soft, sweetish oak finish.
- 63. Oltreme – IGT Salento 2018 Tenute Rubino**
Puglia - Italy **43.00**
Made from 100% Susumaniello grapes – a typical variety of the Brindisi area It matures only in stainless steel vats allowing the primary flavours to fully express themselves. It enchants with simplicity through its fruity and spicy flavours. Intense ruby red with purple highlights. Red fruits such as cherry, pomegranate, raspberry and ripe plums. A balanced velvety wine with elegant tannins.
- 64. Barbera D’Asti, Le Rocchette 2016 Olim Bauda**
Piedmont - Italy **38.00**
Garnet red with purple hues. On the nose it shows complex, subtle, deep aromas with well balanced notes of ripened fruit, plum, cocoa and spice.
- 65. Chateau Lamothe Cissac, 2015/16 Haut Medoc Cru Bourgeois**
Bordeaux – France **44.00**
A traditional style of Bordeaux that has elegance and savoury fruit in abundance. Medium bodied with integrated tannins and cedary oak flavours on a long, complex finish.
- 66. Rioja Reserva, 2014 Luis Canas**
Rioja – Spain **45.00**
Produced from the finest vintages, Luis Canas Reserva is aged in oak to give a mellow but complex and full flavoured red.
- 67. Chateau Ferrand, 2012/14 St. Emilion Grand Cru**
Bordeaux – France **75.00**
Ripe, plummy fruits with hints of cassis and cedar. Well structured; a wine of great elegance and complexity.
- 68. Cabernet Sauvignon, 2017 Cartlidge & Brown**
California - USA **45.00**
This Cabernet starts out with rich, delicious red fruits on the nose that flows into cherry, watermelon, candied plum and crème brûlée. The soft, yet fine, tannins have notes of coffee, rose petals and wet slate.

- 69. Bodegas Emilio Moro, 2019 Finca Resalso**
Do Ribera Del Duero, Spain **35.00**
 Deep cherry red in colour with a violet rim. It is honest, intense, and expressive on the nose. The primary aromas of Tempranillo, such as blackberry & blackcurrant, stand out. Well structured in the mouth, with mellow tannins & a well-balanced acidity.
- 70. Chateau Haut Baradieu, 2011 Saint-Estephe**
Bordeaux - France **69.00**
 A full, flavoursome, superbly constructed wine. A true Saint-Estèphe with its strong character and powerful tannins, full of charm and complexity. The tannins appear progressively to give the wine body and support a long, smooth finish.
- 71. Cabernet Sauvignon, 2014 Paul Hobbs, Crossbarn Napa Valley**
California - USA **73.00**
 A palate of plums, wild berries, thyme, clove and vanilla. Creamy fine grain tannins from front to finish. Rich, savoury flavours that coat the mouth entirely and continuously.
- 72. Chateau Dauzac, 2015 Margaux Grand Cru Classe**
Bordeaux - France **95.00**
 The 2015 Dauzac has a classy, sophisticated bouquet of blackberry, cedar and light fennel aromas; a floral element emerges with just a few swirls of the glass. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy red fruit, fine grip and good acidity. This is a more opulent Margaux, but one that is well-crafted.
- 73. Qupe Syrah Central Coast – USA** **49.00**
 A rich intense wine from a popular winery

- 80. Torrontes Tardio, Zuccardi**
Mendoza – Argentina **23.50**
 A delicate sweet wine with pear, apricots and citrus aromas. It will drive your taste buds nuts with fresh fruit and honey flavours. 500ml Bottle
- 81. Coteaux Du Layon, Carte d’Or, 2017 Baumard**
Loire - France **4.95** **24.95**
 A very attractive honeyed nose, with lifted yellow fruits and more golden tropical elements such as mango, guava and pineapple. 375ml Bottle
